On a Motion by Ms. Murray, seconded by Ms. Nelson, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved to adopt Resolution 2020-05; Approving Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and Setting the Public Hearing for August 13, 2020 at 5:30 p.m., for the Panther Trails Community Development District.

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ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Staff Reports 98

Monthly Aquatic Report

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The Board reviewed Solitude's aquatic maintenance reports and received 102 an update from Mr. Peter Simoes with Solitude Aquatic Maintenance. The Board 103 104 discussed the issue of trash in the ponds and requested staff get a proposal to have the storm inlets cleaned. The Board also requested staff to get a proposal to 105 have Solitude clean the trash from the ponds. The Board discussed the possible 106 acquisition of solar powered aeration for pond #4 and determined not to proceed 107 with this at that time. The Board was informed that aquatic plants were installed in 108 pond #4 the previous day. The Board requested Solitude to perform a test install 109

of water lilies into pond #4 and Mr. Simoes, indicated the small test sample would cost less than \$50.

B. Field Inspection Report

The Board reviewed the Field Service Inspection report prepared by Patrick Bell and received a landscape update from Ms. Paula Mean, with LMP. The Board considered an LMP proposal for landscape improvements to the CDD owned vacant lot parcel. Mr. Cox opened the floor for audience comments on the proposal.

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On a Motion by Ms. Murray, seconded by Ms. Macsuga, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the LMP landscape proposal for the CDD owned vacant parcel for a not-to-exceed amount of \$500.00, for the Panther Trails Community Development District.

122 The Board requested that staff get a proposal from LMP for mowing the 123 drainage ditch along Symmes Road. The Board also provided LMP with guidance 124 regarding installing perennials versus annuals in current beds and Ms. Mean 125 indicated she would create proposals.

C. District Counsel

Not present.

D. District Engineer

133 Mr. Woodcock provided an action plan for the response to the Southwest 134 Florida Water Management District's Consent Order regarding water use permit 135 violations. He noted that the readings for the last few months were within limits. 136 He also provided an update on the pool resurfacing project. He presented a 137 change order for the pool ladder anchor replacement work required by Pool 138 Doctor.

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On a Motion by Ms. Murray, seconded by Ms. Nelson, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the Pool Doctor proposal for ladder anchors for \$1,000.00, for the Panther Trails Community Development District.

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The Board also discussed the need for Mr. Woodcock to inspect some stormwater structures and drainage repairs. Ms. Macsuga confirmed that Mr. Woodcock would oversee the hand-over of the completed pool back to the District. He noted the completion date was still on schedule.

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Mr. Cox discussed the issue of residents wanting to clear portions of their
 private property and explained that it was the responsibility of the residents and
 not the CDD to clear this property as long as it was not restricted from clearing.
 Ms. Macsuga requested that Mr. Cox provide a response to the residents.

The Board discussed options to redesign the playground area to create an area where the mulch does not wash out. Mr. Cox explained one plan to create better drainage. Mr. Woodcock informed the Board that he would inspect the area to see if a better plan could be developed, such as installing sod.

E. Clubhouse Manager

The Board received a Clubhouse report from Helena Teixeira. She provided information regarding the amenity opening plan. She informed the Board that the renovated pool furniture is completed and will mostly remain wrapped during the initial opening. She noted that all fitness equipment is fixed and ready to be re-installed. Mr. Altman suggested that the Board consider having NO LITTERING signs installed.

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F. District Manager

Mr. Cox reminded the Board that the next meeting will be held on June 11, 2020 and that the final budget will be presented at the August 13, 2020 meeting along with holding the budget public hearing.

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Mr. Cox also provided a review of the current action item list and reviewed the financials with the Board members.

Mr. Cox announced the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections registered voter count as of April 15, 2020 is 1408. Seats 4 and 5 are up for election on November 3, 2020 and the qualifying period is June 8, 2020 through June 12, 2020.

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Ms. Macsuga discussed the re-opening of the clubhouse and amenities.
